### Parking Decals and Lockers

Parking decals will be sold to any licensed driver who agrees to abide by school policy. Students need to bring with them a valid drivers license ( No Learner Permits ), vehicle registration, proof of insurance and a completed parking form with a student and notarized parent signature ( see attached ) and the \$80.00 fee must be submitted at the time of purchase in Student Services. 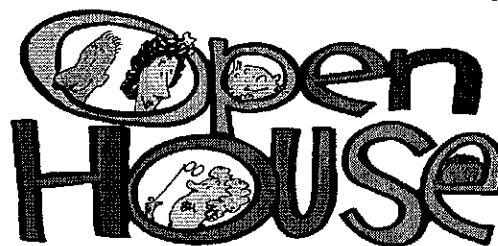

# Procedures for Leaving Campus

## Permission to Leave (P.T.L)

A Permission to leave (P.T.L) Pass is required for a student to leave campus before the end of the school day. Permission to leave (P.T.L) passes are available for students to leave for doctor's/dentist appointments and/or emergencies.

**Note: On days when state/finals testing is being conducted West Boca will be considered a closed campus. This means that NO permission to leave passes will be issued.**

**Remember that there will be no permission to leave (P.T.L) passes issued after 2:15**

**How to get a Permission to leave Pass (P.T.L)** There are three ways to get a Permission to leave Pass.

### **Written Note (RECOMMENDED FOR QUICK ACCURATE PASS)**

To request a Permission to leave Pass the student must bring a note to Student Services prior to the first bell. The note must contain the following information:

- Students full name
- Student ID number
- Time of Student Release
- Reason for Permission to leave Pass
- Parent signature
- Parent phone number

### Via Phone

Parents/Guardians can call Student Services at 561-672-2942 or 561-672-2029. The call must meet the following criteria:

- The call must be made a least one hour prior to pick up time.
- The call CAN ONLY be made by a PARENT / GUARDIAN listed in the student's records.
- The call must be made from a phone number on file in the student record.

### In-Person

A Permission to Leave Pass (P.T.L) can be obtained in person by visiting Student Services. Please note that when a Permission to Leave Pass (P.T.L) is requested in person it may take 30 minutes or more to get the student out of class. The person who signs out the student must meet the following criteria:

- Have a government issued Photo ID
- Must already be listed on the student records contact list.

# **DRESS CODE**

**West Boca High School has adapted these dress code modifications since the school has opened. We hope this will help with some of the questions.**

Students - The dress code has been in effect since the first day the school has opened. If an Assistant Principal stops you in passing to speak to you about dress code violation, what you are wearing to school is not fine. If the behavior continues, you will face consequences for your actions. If you have any additional, questions please ask any Assistant Principal.

## **Jeans**

Jeans that purchased ripped by design are allowed. The ones that are altered and ripped higher and expose more epidermis then necessary are not allowed.

## **Leggings / Tights.**

Yes, you can wear them. As long as the shirt that you wear with them is long enough to cover your abdominal area including your waistline while you walk and if, you raise your hand if you answer a question.

## **Shorts**

Do not have to be knee length but must be appropriate in size.

## **Shirts / Tops**

All shirts and tops must have sleeves on them.

## **Tank tops / basketball jerseys**

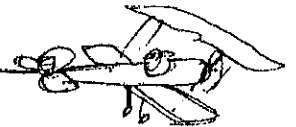
You may wear them as long as you wear a t-shirt with sleeve underneath the tank or jersey.

## **Head covering**

Head coverings are NOT permitted!! (Exceptions: Medical / Religious reasons through Student Services)

\*\* all clothing with words, phrases, symbols, picture or insignia which are disruptive, obscene, profane, racist, suggestive, offensive, or related to drugs or alcohol use are prohibited.

# INFORMATION



## NO CELL PHONES !!!

Technology is a wonderful thing, however, the prevalence of cell phones can be a major distraction to the educational process. Cell phones have been used to photograph tests and text answers to other students. Additionally, phones that vibrate or ring during class time disrupt the flow of the lesson. For this reason, the Palm Beach County District School Board has established a policy that allows students to bring cell phones to school. In the classroom the teacher will let the student know when they are allowed to use their cell phones for educational use. Parents who need to contact their students in an emergency situation must do so by contacting Student Services at 672-2029. In the classroom if a student is seen with their cell phone displayed, the phone will be confiscated by the staff member present. The phone will be turned in to Student Services where it will be locked up. Parents will then be required to come to Student Services in order to retrieve the phone. If a student's phone is confiscated a second time, a Saturday detention will be issued. Any additional infractions will be viewed as insubordination and will result in additional disciplinary consequences.

### Community Service Guidelines

Students of the School District of Palm Beach County are required to obtain a minimum of 20 community service hours to graduate from high school. Community service is also a requirement for many scholarships ( i.e., Bright Futures ) and college entrance programs. The purpose of community service is for students to engage in activities that help them develop an appreciation for the concept of service to the school or community. New school guideline have been established for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. All community service must list individual dates and times and hours worked. One event per sheet and turned into student services 30 days after completion of the event.

Students have 2 days upon returning to school to bring in a note to the attendance clerk in Student Services. If a student is going to be absent for an extended period of time please contact the attendance clerk / guidance councilor to make arrangements to get make-up work. 561-672-2942

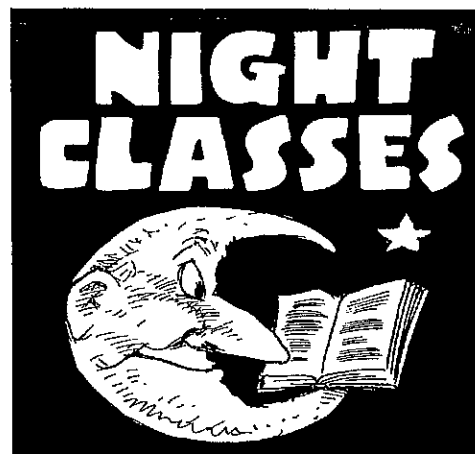

- The parking decal or hang-tag must be on display through the front windshield and the permit number easily viewed from the outside of the vehicle at all times while on campus.
- The parking decal or hang-tag must be used for the vehicle identified within this permit. Any changes in vehicle use or specific vehicle being driven must be submitted to the school immediately.
- Violation of any traffic or criminal laws and/or School District/school rules.
- Discourteous, reckless, or defiant road behavior.
- Exceeding speed limit by 5 mph on campus.
- Unsafe acts, (i.e. riding on car hoods, bumpers, radiators, fenders, spinning wheels, burning rubber, running board, etc.) will result in suspension of parking privileges.
- Unauthorized vehicles will not be permitted on campus. These vehicles will be towed away at the owner's expense or booted with a \$25.00 removal fee.
- Students are not permitted to remain in parking lots or to sit in parked vehicles before school, during school, during lunch, or at the completion of the school day.
- Students are to park in their designated parking lots only. Students are not permitted to park in staff parking lots, visitor lots or in non-designated parking areas.
- Any student caught duplicating or falsifying a parking permit or transferring the permit to another person will lose their parking permit privilege.
- A radio, tape player, or other mechanical sound making device or instrument from within the motor vehicle cannot be louder than necessary for the convenient hearing by persons inside the vehicle in areas adjoining the school.
- Students shall not use cell phones or other wireless devices while driving.
- Operators of motor vehicles must use seat belts and passengers must use seat belts or child restraining devices as required by law.
- No student is allowed to ride in the back of a pick-up or flat-bed truck.
- If an accident occurs on campus and is not reported immediately to the administration by the student(s) involved, then the student(s) will lose their parking privileges for the duration of the school year and/or duration of their enrollment at the school.

**Schools may adopt additional rules.**

**Read the following carefully before signing below.**

I understand that the parking lot is public property, which is under the control of the school. I will prominently display the school issued parking permit on the vehicle designated on this form. I agree that the vehicle the student drives onto property of The School District of Palm Beach County, Florida (The School District) will not be used to transport or store contraband of any kind, nor will the student violate any rules listed in the Student Handbook or the School District Code of Conduct, nor will the student violate any State Uniform Traffic Control or criminal laws. I hereby understand and give the School District of Palm Beach County and the school listed on this form my consent for the principal/designee to search the vehicle the student brings onto School District property upon reasonable suspicion that illegal, prohibited, harmful items or substances, or stolen property may be concealed therein. I acknowledge that refusal to cooperate with the request to search my vehicle shall result in the revocation of the student's parking permit for two (2) years from the date of refusal. If the student's vehicle is on School District property without the appropriate decal displayed, said vehicle may be towed at my expense. Any violation of the above may result in the loss of the student's parking privileges. I also understand that the school listed on this form and The School District of Palm Beach County are NOT responsible or liable for any damage to my vehicle or the contents within it. I have been advised to keep my car locked.

"By issuance of this permit, the School District of Palm Beach County does not assume liability for any property damage to any private vehicle parked on the property. The owner/operator(s) of all private vehicles accept responsibility for their own property and agree that they are parking at their own risk."

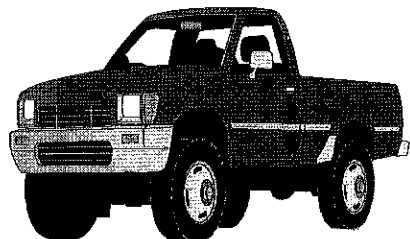
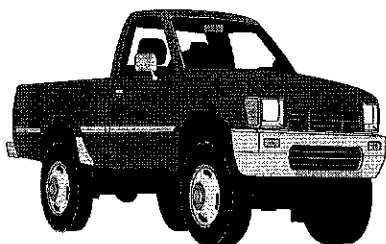

**Parking hang tags must be displayed from rear view mirror at all times.**

**These following rules will be strickly enforced by school personnel.**

I understand that parking at WBRHS is a privilege. I hereby agree to abide by the following rules:

1. Park in my numbered, assigned spot only, parallel to the painted lines.
2. Permit must be clearly visible and affixed to the back side of the rearview mirror.
3. Parking in a spot labeled STAFF, VISITOR, or another student's assigned spot will result in a Saturday detention.
4. No parking permitted along curbs, on the grass, or any lot other than that specified.
5. No speeding or reckless driving. Violators are subject to suspension.

12. Students are not to use their vehicle as a locker. You must obtain permission to enter the parking lot once school is in session.

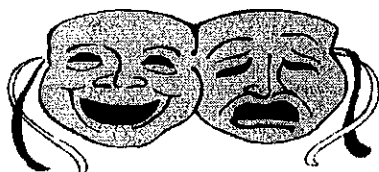

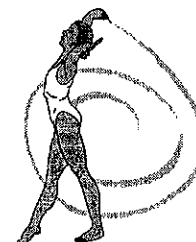
